### What is the IHP?

1. The Integrated HIV Plan (IHP) is required work of the State of New Hampshire's HIV Prevention and Care Programs that is prepared and implemented by the NH HIV Planning Group (HPG). The IHP Workgroup oversees the work of the IHP, including any barriers, outcomes, and updates.

### What is our Workgroup's Goal?

1. Prevent New HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis and Syringe Service Programs.

### What are our workgroup's Objectives?

1. Increase uptake of Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis by 10% in five years.
2. Increase number of people accessing SSP services by 5% in five years.
3. Increase treatment as prevention efforts (U=U) by diagnosing People with HIV (PWH) as early as possible and getting them into care to achieve and maintain viral suppression by 2% in five years.

### Where to begin?

1. Review existing goals.
2. What roadblocks (problems) do we see to accomplishing this goal?
  - a. Thinking about this in a proactive manner, instead of reacting when we get to the problem.
  - b. What do we have control of and what can we influence?
3. Determine if we can achieve these and do we have all the players at the table to do so?
  - a. If yes, what do we need to begin the work?
  - b. If we decide we cannot achieve these goals, how are we going to address these differently?
